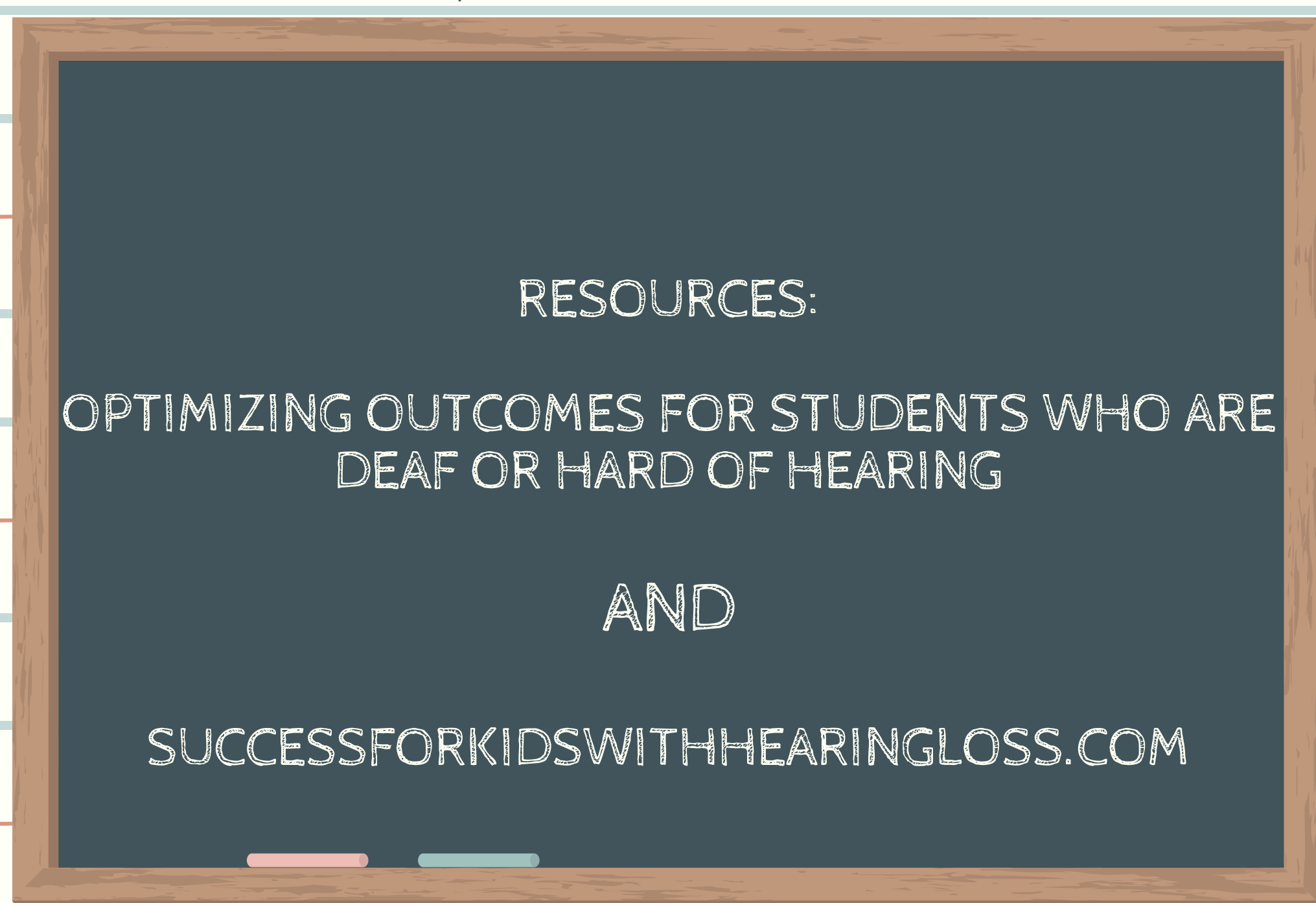


Supporting Students with Hearing Loss
